Grandparents' Day: Grandparents' / Grandfriends' Day (sponsored by the HSA) is this Friday, September 11th from 8:30 – 9:30. The festivities will be in the classrooms where a light brunch of bagels, juice, and coffee will be served. Grandparents can park in the lot behind the school or on the street.

Parking Alert: An email was sent out last week after a visit from the SLC Motor Squad. Remember there is no double parking allowed in front of the school. Cars waiting to pick up a student must be stopped to the right of the cement runoff drain just behind the parked cars. **You may not leave your cars unless you are parked in a legal parking space.** The Motor Squad will be patrolling the area and issuing tickets to offenders. If you park across the street, your children must go to the corner to be crossed by the crossing guard.

Lunch Program: The lunch form for October is attached. Please be sure to complete it and send it to the office with payment by September 15th if you haven't already done so. A lunch card will be prepared for your child showing the days you have purchased lunch. This way your child is sure to get the lunches you bought. Milk is available for purchase daily for \$.25 a day. Please send a quarter with your child on the day you want milk. Otherwise, water is available. We are now using trays, silverware, and plastic tumblers instead of throwaways. This will help save money and the environment (as long as the children remember not to throw the silverware away!).

Parents' Night Out: The 8th grade class is sponsoring a fundraiser to benefit the Diocesan Good Samaritan Program this Friday, September 11th. A check will be presented to the Bishop at the Diocesan 8th grade Mass at the Cathedral on September 23rd. Please see the attached flyer for details.

NO PARKING: Please remember that there is **NO PARKING** in the Rectory driveway. That space is for church and rectory visitors. Short term (15 minute) parking is available for visitors in the first 3 spaces in front of the school door. Volunteers who come for lunch and recess should park in the 2 hour spaces (the first 5 spaces at the beginning of the fence near the Pre-k.).
