Research suggests that music lessons provide children with important developmental benefits beyond simply the knowledge of skill of playing an instrument. Music lessons may enhance intelligence and academic achievement, build self-esteem, and provide discipline. Skills learned through music transfer to study skills, communication skills, and cognitive skills useful in every part of a child's developmental progression. A relationship between music and the strengthening of math, reading, creative thinking, and visual arts skills has also been reported.

- Classes are taught in a group setting based on level and experience. We focus on rhythm, note reading, keyboard geography, technique, and performance skills.
