Never skied or snowboarded before.



*Skiers: you stop and make slight turns on a beginner slope.
Riders: you heel slide, stop, and are working on turns.*



*Skiers: you can link turns on easy runs.
Riders: you link toe and heel turns on easier runs.*



*Skiers: you make mostly parallel turns on all blue runs.
Riders: you link turns and ride comfortably all blue runs.*



*Skiers: you ski parallel, enjoy exploring easier black runs, easy bumps, and skiing off the tram at Snowbird.
Riders: you link turns on advanced (black) runs and enjoy riding off the tram at Snowbird.*



*Skiers: you can make carved, short turns on advanced (black) runs and you seek out off-trail conditions.
Riders: you link turns on advanced (black) runs, seek out off-trail conditions, and may do jumps and tricks.*



*Skiers: you ski on and off trail conditions and steep and narrow terrain with skill and confidence.
Riders: you confidently ride on and off trail conditions, steep and narrow terrain, and freestyle moves.*
