



## OLOL Ski/Snowboard School Program 2012



The total cost will be \$258.00 for the six lessons (2 ½ hours each). This includes the six lessons, bus transportation to and from the resort, and snacks. To keep the price set, we need a minimum of 75 kids, so sign up now!

The lessons are taught by Snowbird instructors. The students must be 7 years old or older to participate. The lesson price does not include ski or snowboard rentals. Each student will need to have their own equipment (own or rental), they will bring all equipment with them to school on the given Fridays. Helmets are required and strongly recommended for all students!  
Lesson dates are JAN. 6, 13, 20, 27, FEB. 3, and 10.

**Registration will be closed after Wednesday, December 14.** Please be sure to have all five forms ( Behavior Agreement, Snowbird waiver, School Release, Para Consent & Shirt order) into the office by then—Snowbird is very firm about this. For the Ski & Snowboard program, you may pay by cash or check (payable to Our Lady of Lourdes). We will need one registration/emergency form per student. Additionally, a Behavior Agreement form **MUST** be signed by all registered students and a parent or guardian. Extra forms can be obtained from the school office. Both forms must be turned in or your student's registration is **NOT** considered complete.

There is **NO** refund on the bus fee, and it is up to Snowbird to determine whether or not they refund you for the lessons.

On "Ski/Board Fridays", boys and girls must enter school through the gym door with equipment and clothing, and leave the equipment on the stage. All participants will go to the gym at 12:00 pm to change for skiing/boarding. Boys & girls can leave their belongings in the gym or take them. Students will leave OLOL no later than 12:30pm, arrive at Snowbird and have lessons from 1:30pm until 4:00pm. They will leave Snowbird at approximately 4:15pm and return to OLOL at about 5:00pm. Please make arrangements to have your child go to extended care if you can not pick them up on time. Chaperons will stay with the students until 5:00pm. After that time, **ALL** students not picked up will be sent to extended day, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

To make the program possible, volunteers are needed and appreciated. We need parent chaperons for each ski/board Friday. Chaperons should sign in at the office not later than 11:45am. If you can help out please fill out the bottom of the Behavior Agreement form with the dates you can chaperon and leave your email and a contact number. We will do our best to give everyone that signs up a chance to help. Chaperones will receive a complimentary pass to use while the students are in lessons, and your time counts as VIP hours!

This program is meant to be for the enjoyment of all of the kids. If you would like to donate a scholarship for kids that need financial assistance please include any extra amount on the check with your registration form and note the child you would like to sponsor, or if you don't have a specific child in mind, we will pick. If you need assistance contact me. This will be kept confidential.
